THE MANAGEMENT OF **CHRONIC COUGH**

& RELATED DISORDERS

Cough is a common complaint which affects many people, including professional voice users. Acute cough resolves spontaneously, but what about the chronic cough that persists despite medical and pharmacological treatment?

Cough may be due to a variety of factors ranging from respiratory infection, asthma, rhinitis and reflux to pollution or smoky environment. Because of its complexity, the diagnosis and treatment of individuals with chronic cough involves an interdisciplinary team. The day will cover allergy, pulmonary medicine and ENT, exploring pathophysiology and treatment options. The role of speech therapy and respiratory physiotherapy treatment for chronic cough will be discussed. We will also hear about singing for lung health, an initiative supported by the *British Lung Foundation*.
